## Why a Mediterranean Youth parliament for wetlands?

Because sensitizing and educating young generations for tackling environmental problems is obviously essential to ensuring awareness of the need for the sustainable development of the planet.

Because they will be the responsible adults and decision makers of tomorrow.

Because these young generations are a crucial vector of communication with respect to the wider public and policy makers to develop a new vision of the use of the planet's resources.

Initiating an awareness approach to this younger audience therefore has a dual significance:

- **-Short-term:** the younger generations become bearers of a message. More so than adults, the voices of young people simply reflect reality and are heard by the authorities as being objective, devoid of ulterior motives and hostility.
- Long term: already aware of the challenges related to the careful management of the environment, tomorrow's decision makers will act in a much more effective way than ours often do;

### The objectives of the Mediterranean Youth Parliament for Wetlands :

The basic aim of the project is to contribute to the conservation and wise use of wetlands as part of integrated water resources management in the Mediterranean.

To achieve this goal, the project will pursue two specific interconnected objectives:

- Involve and train young students in Mediterranean schools in the conservation of wetlands,
- Involve them in the strengthening of decentralized cooperation in the Mediterranean through intercultural exchange and technology transfer among students, NGOs and parliamentarians from the same country and between different countries in the region.






